

J. Willis Cantey Memorial Golf Classic

J. Willis Cantey distinguished himself as a soldier, businessman, banker and natural leader in Columbia, SC. While attending USC, Cantey joined the South Carolina National Guard, and upon graduation in 1938, he was commissioned an infantry lieutenant. This was the start of his long affiliation with service and dedication to his country.

In 1940, his National Guard unit was mobilized as part of the 30th "Old Hickory" Division. He served in the Army until World War II ended in 1945.

A lieutenant colonel at age 24, he was the youngest battalion commander in the United States Army. His decorations included three Silver Star medals for gallantry in action, four Bronze Star medals for heroic achievement, the Legion of Merit for exceptional meritorious service, the Purple Heart, and the French Le Croix de Guerre for bravery.

He remained in the Army Reserves after the war, retiring in 1955. In 1981, he was appointed the Civilian Aide for South Carolina to the Secretary of the Army.

In 1985, he received the first award for distinguished service given by the Palmetto Chapter of the Association of the United States Army.

For his bravery, dedication and service we honor the memory of J. Willis Cantey.

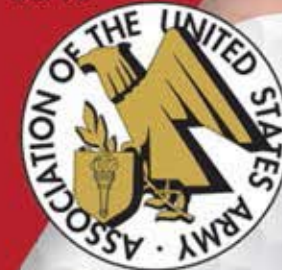
