



## COVID-19 In-Person Events/Meetings Guidelines

The Columbia Chamber is actively monitoring COVID-19 reports in our region and taking measures to prevent the spread of the disease by following Federal CDC guidelines and all state and local mandates/guidance.

For all Columbia Chamber functions, please stay at home if you feel ill in any way. Likewise, if you become sick with COVID-19 symptoms, have tested positive for COVID-19, are awaiting the results of a COVID-19 test, or have been exposed to someone with symptoms or someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19, please stay home.

If you do choose to attend an in-person Columbia Chamber function, please keep in mind the following guidelines: \*

- Health checks such as temperature screening and/or symptom checking will be required prior to admittance. Per CDC guidelines, if you have a temperature reading of 100.4°F or higher, you will not be admitted to the function.
- We ask that you maintain a six-foot social distance at all times during the function.
- Masks or face coverings will be required at all times during the function unless eating or drinking. Please do not take your mask off or pull it down while talking, especially if in close proximity to others. We encourage you to bring your own mask or face covering, however, masks will be available if needed.
- Alcohol-based hand sanitizer will be available, and we encourage you to wash your hands often with soap and water.
- To comply with social distancing recommendations and Columbia Chamber guidelines, the number of participants will be limited. Pre-registrations are mandatory for all functions at this time. We regret that we will not be able to accommodate walk-ins.
